



PUBLIC NOTICE

Mandatory Water Restrictions

Due to current drought conditions and reduced river water flow, the Town of Woodstock will begin **mandatory water restrictions for all non-essential water activities** including:

- Washing of paved areas is prohibited except for health and safety requirements.
- Filling and replenishing of swimming pools is prohibited except to maintain health and safety.
- Non-commercial washing of vehicles is prohibited. Commercial vehicle washing businesses are permitted to operate under normal conditions.
- Watering established landscaping and vegetable gardens is prohibited except for watering by buckets of up to five gallons in size per day.
- All watering of new landscaping is permitted for the first 30 days after planting. Thereafter, the restriction for established landscaping shall apply.
- Restaurants shall serve water to customers only upon request.
- Use of water for the operation of ornamental fountains, artificial waterfalls, misting machines, and reflecting pools is prohibited.
- Other water use is limited to uses essential for business and human hygiene.

Anyone found in violation of these mandatory restrictions is subject to penalties as established by the Town Code Sections 82-70 and 82-71.
